1 Define Purpose

Keep health, human benefit, and mission in view.



2 Apply Context

Interpret the environment, relationships, and situational nuance.



3 Use Judgment

Weigh tradeoffs, ambiguity, and consequence when decisions matter.



4 Uphold Ethics

Protect fairness, dignity, safety, and responsible use.



5 Build Trust

Communicate clearly, preserve transparency, and sustain confidence.



6 Stay Accountable

Ensure humans remain answerable for the choices made.
