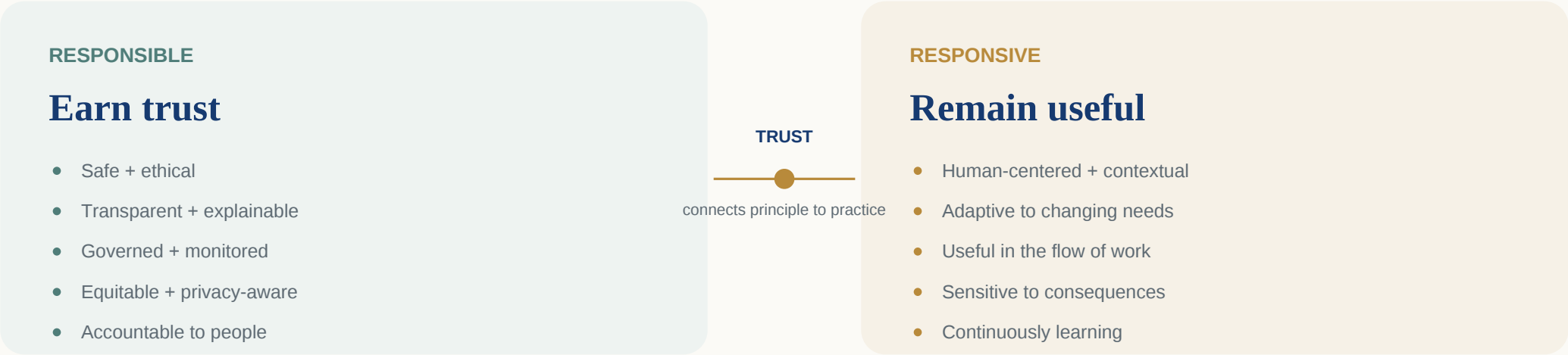


Responsible + Responsive AI

- PROGRESS** How will impact be monitored and improved?

FROM PRINCIPLE TO PRACTICE

01 INTENT

Define the human purpose.

02 ASSESS

Understand value, risk and equity.

03 GOVERN

Set decision rights and guardrails.

04 OPERATE

Keep humans meaningfully in the loop.

05 LEARN

Monitor outcomes, trust and change.
